QuickTime Player (or QuickTime X if you are running OS X 10.5 or 10.6) comes with the QuickTime Player 10 (10.2.5) application. This article is a quick guide to help you start creating a high quality MPEG video from QuickTime Player. To finish the process, it is recommended to use another application such as ImgBurn or MacDV to create a DVD video. QuickTime Player 10 (or QuickTime X if you are running OS X 10.5 or 10.6) is an application that enables you to play and create high quality media files. This is a QuickTime Player plug-in, so the QuickTime Player 10 (10.2.5) application must be installed before you can use it. There are two ways to install QuickTime Player 10 (or QuickTime X if you are running OS X 10.5 or 10.6). To install QuickTime Player from the Mac OS X application store, first open the Mac OS X store application, then open QuickTime Player 10. To install QuickTime Player from the QuickTime Player download page, open the page in your browser and follow the instructions to download QuickTime Player. Video File Formats Supported QuickTime Player 10 (or QuickTime X if you are running OS X 10.5 or 10.6) supports many different video formats. The supported formats include: 3GP and AVI files MP4 (popular formats such as MP4 and H.264) QuickTime (.mov and .qt extensions) All the .mov files play just fine. The AVI files may take a little longer to play. MP4 files can be played just fine. The .qt files will play just fine. Video Configuration Settings The QuickTime Player 10 (10.2.5) application allows you to configure the video settings. The following screen is an example of the video configuration settings. The values that you have to edit are on the left side of the screen, and the default values are in the center. Video (QuickTime Player 10) configuration settings Movie Quality The movie quality settings are part of the playback settings and will affect the quality of the video that you are about to create. The quality settings are 82157476af
